## Company / Project Recognition

- Babcock & Brown/BP Alternative Energy's Cedar Creek Wind Farm project has been named 2009 "Best Project - Energy" by the Design Build Institute of America - Upper Midwest Region.
- The Fox Valley Branch of the American Public Works Association chose the Kane County Adult Justice Center as its 2008 "Project of the Year" for its dedication to providing high quality public works goods and services.
- The Construction Industry Service Corporation chose the Kane County Adult Justice Center for the 2008 "Pride in Construction Project of the Year Award" based on quality of construction, design, impact on the community, and an outstanding safety record.
- The U. S. Navy and Mortenson were selected by the Construction Owners Association of America to receive a Special Award for the NAVFAC Submarine Escape Training School Project. The Award is given to the owner whose design/construction team has achieved excellence through cooperative efforts in project management.
- The Crowne Plaza Hotel won the National DBIA award in the 'Private Sector Building Over \$15 Million' category, and the Navy's Submarine Escape Training Facility won in the "Public Sector Building Under \$15 Million" category. Recipients of the National Design-Build Awards are chosen for "advanced and innovative application of total integrated project delivery and finding unique solution for project challenges."
- Several projects were awarded *Colorado Construction's* 2008 Hard Hat Awards: Colorado College Cornerstone Arts Center; University of Denver's Anschutz Medical Campus Research Complex II; Mile Hi Church Sanctuary Expansion; and phase I of the Vestas Blade Facility.
- *Colorado Construction* magazine featured Mortenson's Denver Operating Group Research Complex 2 project as one of the top projects in 2008.
- The Aurora Medical Center team was honored with WasteCap's 2008 "Big Diverter Award". The team has achieved an astounding 94.94% recycling rate for construction and demolition on the new facility. This is the third year in a row that a Mortenson project has achieved this special recycling award.



## Safety Awards

- Mortenson's TCF Bank Stadium project team was recognized for Excellence in Safety Management and the project was designated a Minnesota Safety and Health Achievement Recognition Program (MNSHARP) Construction worksite by the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry.
- Our Denver office was awarded Platinum Level "STEP Award for Safety" by the Associated Builders and Contractors Rocky Mountain Chapter.

The Navy performed safety evaluations and Mortenson scored the highest obtainable score among the 15 projects evaluated.
